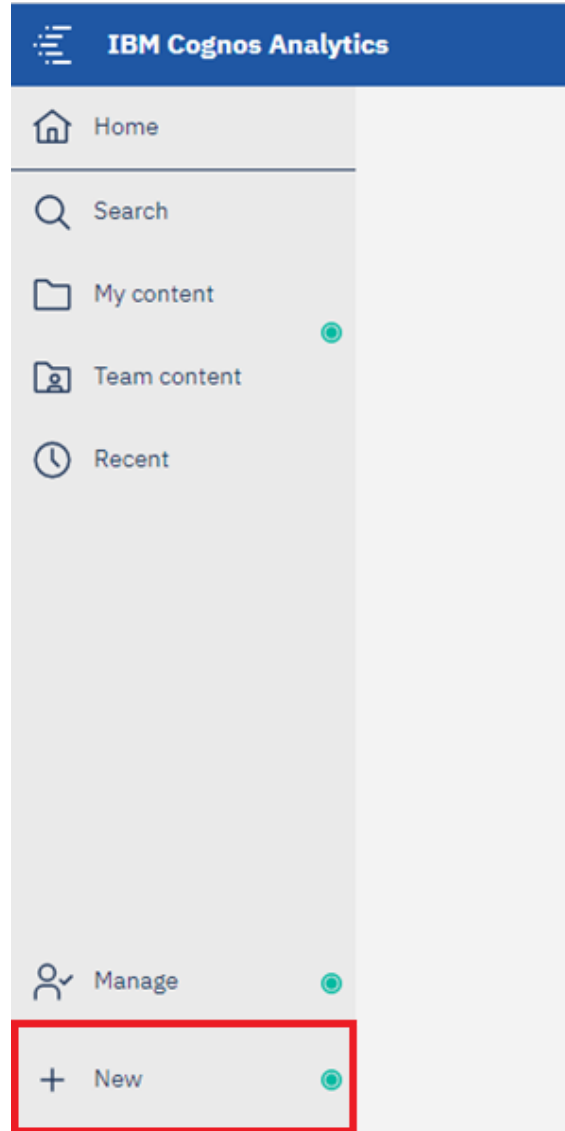


COGNOS RAW: REPORT STUDIO

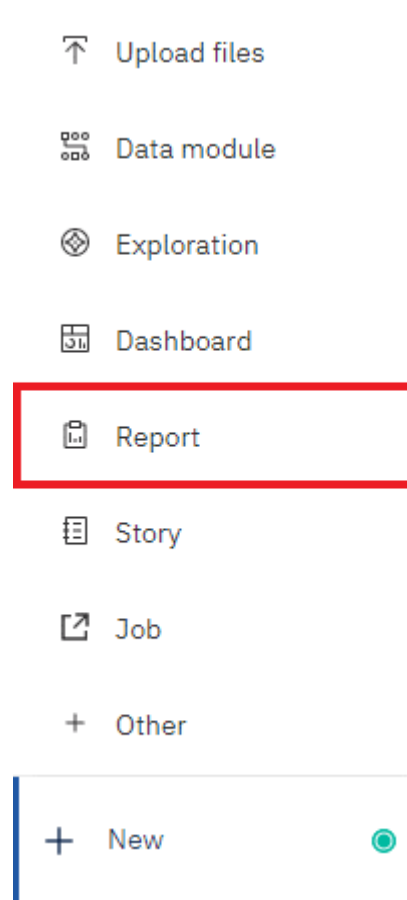

Create a New Report

Click the **plus sign** in lower left corner.



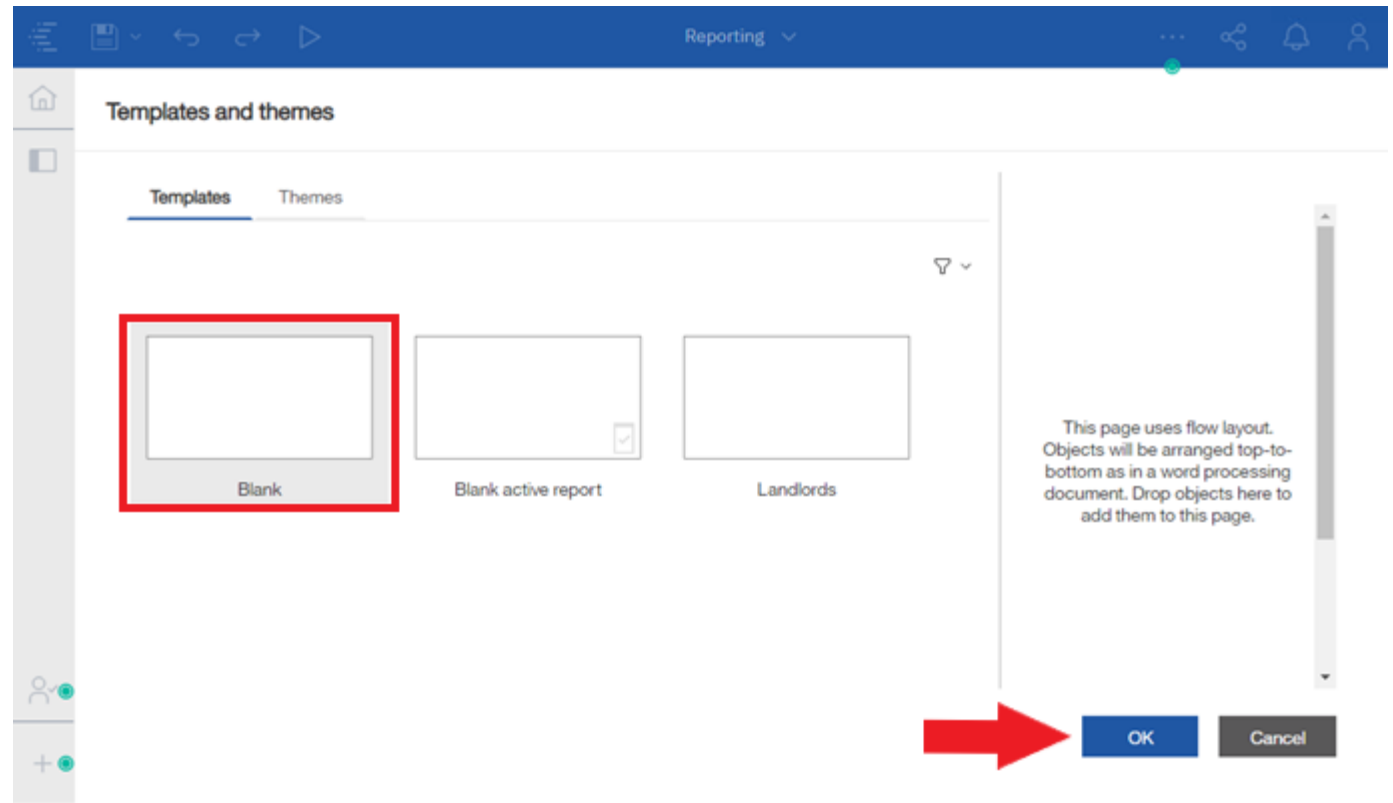
Click **Report**.



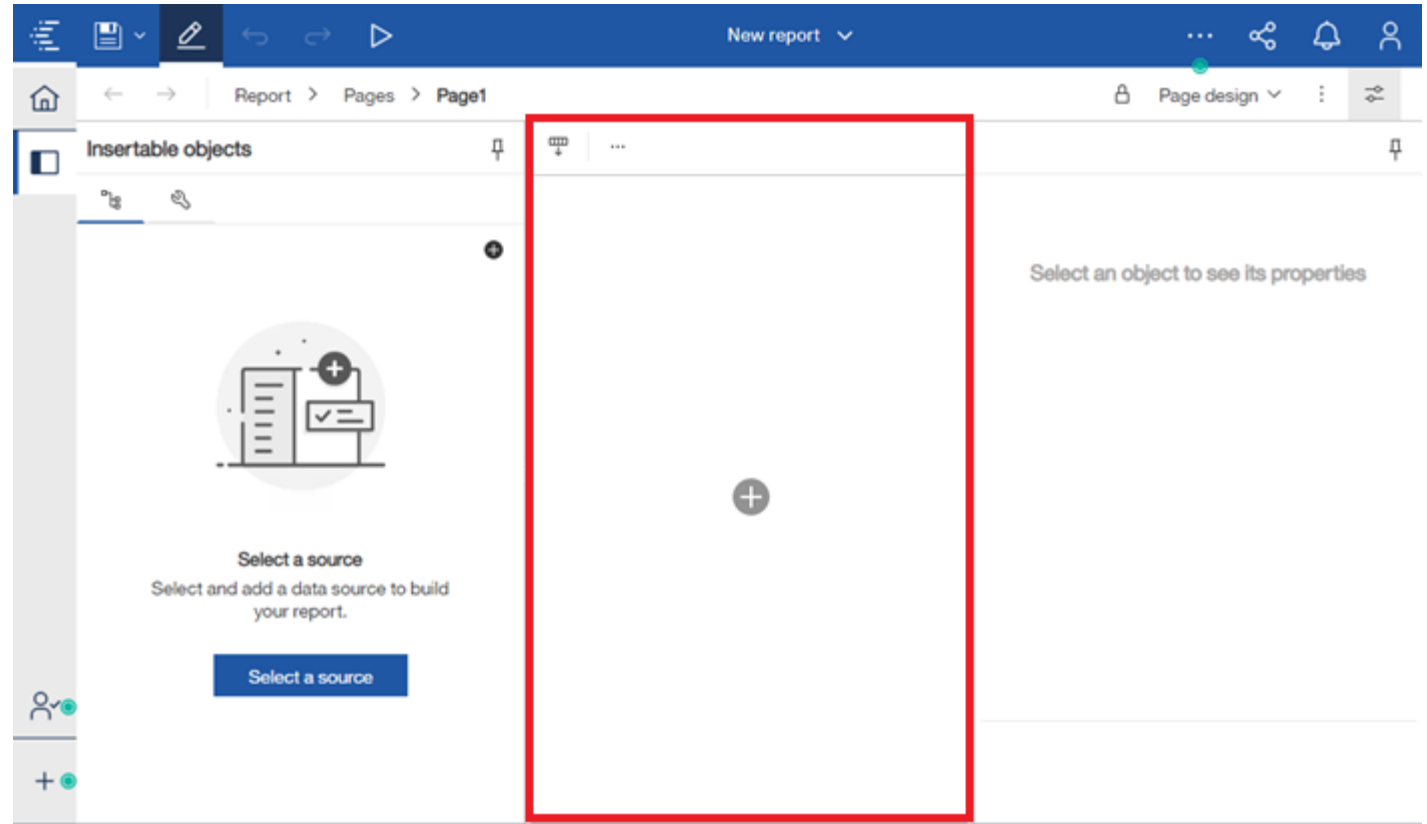
The Templates and Themes page opens.

Select the **Blank** report.

Click **OK**.

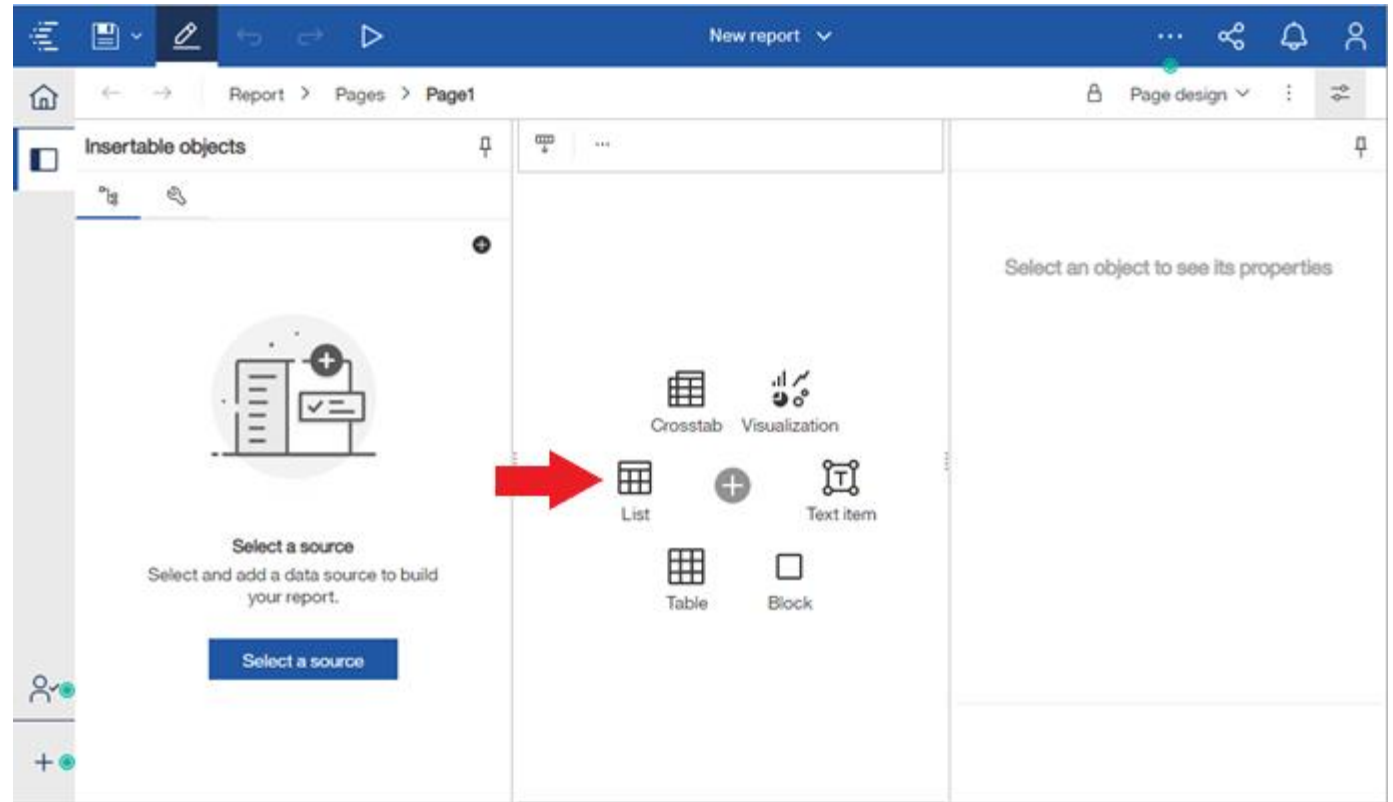


From the center pane, click the **Plus** icon.



Six available report types appear.

Select **List**. This is comparable to Query Studio reports.




A pop-up window appears requesting the **Object and Query name**.
