






May: Environmental Responsibility



<u>May: National Electrical Safety Month</u> Post copy:

Option 1:

Many older homes simply can't handle the demands of today's electrical appliances and devices. Have your home inspected by a qualified electrician if it's older than 40 years or has had a major appliance installed. Learn the warning signs of an overloaded electrical system:

- 1. Frequent tripping of circuit breakers or blowing of fuses
- 2. Dimming of lights when other devices are turned on
- 3. Buzzing sound from switches or outlets
- 4. Discolored outlets
- 5. Appliances that seem underpowered

Option 2:

Prepare your home for safe and efficient energy:

- Use a smart plug or power strip to turn off power to devices not in use.
- LED lightbulbs last longer and use 25-80% less energy than traditional bulbs.
- Utilize home automation to control HVAC and lighting systems while not at home.
- Have an electrician inspect your electrical system every 10 years to avoid overloads
