Financial Highlights

In the second quarter 2019, WPPI Energy's change in net position was \$1,168,694 compared to a loss of \$722,419 in the second quarter 2018. Due to seasonal wholesale rates that include a higher demand charge during the summer months, WPPI Energy anticipates increased revenues and change in net position during the summer months.

Energy sales to members totaled 1,144,574 megawatt-hours (MWh) in the second quarter of 2019. This is 88,881 MWh or 7.2% less than the same period a year ago. Total operating revenues for the second quarter in 2019 were \$98,990,216 or 8.0% lower than the same period a year ago. Total operating expenses for the first quarter in 2019 were \$98,899,829 or 6.9% lower than the same period a year ago. The decrease in operating revenues is primarily due to lower MWh sales to members in the second quarter of 2019 compared to 2018. The decrease in operating expenses in the second quarter 2019 compared to 2018 is driven by lower purchased power and fuel expenses.

Power Supply Update

WPPI Energy's 20% share of Boswell Unit 4 generated 193,748 MWh at an average capacity factor of 75.8% during the second quarter. This compares to generation of 205,922 MWh and an average capacity factor of 80.6% in the second quarter of 2018. Unit 4 was online the entire second quarter of 2019.

WPPI Energy's 8.33% share of the Elm Road units generated 146,700 MWh at an average capacity factor of 63.6% during the second quarter. In the same quarter a year ago, the units generated 194,089 MWh at an average capacity factor of 84.1%. Unit 2 was offline for six and a half weeks during the second quarter of 2019 for a planned turbine valve outage.

News Highlights

Every other year, WPPI Energy senior staff visit utility member governing bodies to discuss current WPPI Energy and electric industry developments, and provide recent accomplishments members have achieved together by partnering through joint action. These presentations allow WPPI Energy the opportunity to maintain relationships with city councils, village boards, utility commissions and other community leaders. Senior staff visited 18 utility member governing bodies in the second quarter of 2019 and will continue to visit additional governing bodies throughout the summer months.

WPPI Energy is a regional power company serving 51 locally owned, not-for-profit electric utilities. Together through WPPI Energy, these public power utilities share resources and own generation facilities to provide reliable, affordable electricity to more than 200,000 homes and businesses in Wisconsin, Michigan's Upper Peninsula and Iowa.
